## Where do I get my food handler card?

## How much does the food handler card cost and how long is it good for?

As of winter 2006, the cost is \$10. The card is good for three years in the state of Oregon. Rates may change so contact Public Health for current fees.

## How do I get a replacement food handler card?

Bring in \$5 to the Public Health building at 403 Pine Street (Environmental Health staff will assist you). If you received your card online then contact [www.ora.org](http://www.ora.org) (Oregon Restaurant Association)

## Do I need a permit to serve food to the public?

Yes. Most food events, temporary or permanent, are required to have a permit.
