

# Food Service Frequently Asked Questions

## *Where do I get my food handler card?*

- Online at [www.ora.org](http://www.ora.org) (Oregon Restaurant Association)
- In person at the Public Health building 403 Pine Street.  
Printed schedules are available. Ask Receptionist

## *How much does the food handler card cost and how long is it good for?*

(As of winter 2006) the cost is \$10... and the card is good for three years in the state of Oregon.

Rates may change so contact Public Health for current fees.

## *How do I get a replacement food handler card?*

Bring in \$5 to the Public Health building at 403 Pine Street (Environmental Health staff will assist you). If you received your card online then contact [www.ora.org](http://www.ora.org) (Oregon Restaurant Association)

## *Do I need a permit to serve food to the public?*

Yes. Most food events, temporary or permanent, are required to have a permit.
